

Judges – Demi Brama



Demi Brama started pole sports when she was 10 years old. When Demi was 11, she competed at Beat Graffiti after this competition Demi got invited to the Dutch national competition (2014) to do a demonstration to see if next year the organization would add the national competition for kids. The

demonstration was a success and in 2015 the first Dutch championship for kids (10-14 and 15-17) was organized. Demi competed and won first place after her success she joined the nationals every year and placed herself multiple times (2016-2017-2018-2019-2021) for the world championship organized by the IPSF (international pole sports federation) where she has won 5 world medals in total. Last year, in 2021 she won 2 silver medals in the category artistic pole and artistic hoop.

Demi is still competing at the Dutch national championships in 2022 she is bringing her team Acrobatic Dreams Team to the nationals. Currently, Demi is training for the nationals and coaching others in her studio Acrobatic Dreams.

Judges – Nils-Anders Gruben

Our next judge is Nils-Anders Gruben. Having



performed at numerous shows and competitions; knowing how to entertain a crowd is his strong suit.

Nils-Anders' pole journey started back in 2012 during clubbing, after which it soon became his

hobby and passion. He started doing competitions in 2016 and founded a pole dance school in 2018: Anders Pole Power in Apeldoorn.

"I want to see a show, attitude is everything during a performance. The audience will feel the way you feel on stage. So bring all of your energy and dance until you drop!

Our last judge is Maurits Kersten.



Maurits has been dancing since 2012 and entered the competitive circuit in 2014, first in mixed doubles, then solo men.

He's taught at several studios over the years, but now you can find him teaching in Pole Inspiration Dance Studio, in Rotterdam and The Hague.

Having repeatedly gone on record as saying "Screw

what the judges think, I'm doing this for ME", Maurits' advice to competitors is to stay true to yourself.

"This is your chance to show what YOU can do. If you try to copy the other people in your competition, you're only restricting yourself.

Don't be afraid to think outside the box a little bit to better show off YOUR style."
